- Points awarded will continue to decrease by 1 point until position 47 which is zero points.
- There will be a 10 (total) point bonus for drivers that attend all six races.
- In order for a class to be eligible for an award, it must have run a minimum of 4 times with a minimum of 4 participants competing through to and participating in the main.
- A single drop will be allowed for this year's series.
- Double points will be awarded at the final race of the season.

# Requirements For All Classes

- All LiPo batteries must have a hard case.
- Batteries must NOT be charged beyond their design voltage (4.20V per cell for standard LiPo's).
- No receiver packs allowed for any classes except for modified classes.
- No "super caps". Capacitors cannot exceed 10,000 micro farads.
- No reverse allowed. It must be locked out in your speed control.
- All vehicles must meet their class's minimum ride height requirements. No part of the vehicle can drag on the carpet. 3mm minimum for 1/12 scale pan cars and 5mm minimum for most other classes. See class rules for specific requirements.
- All vehicles must be free of dirt, mud, oil, etc. Protecting our carpet racing surface is top priority.
- Racers must provide their own transponders. All series tracks accommodate most styles of both 2 and 3 wire transponders.
- If we do not have at least three vehicles in a class, we may (at the race director's discretion) combine classes.

# Code Of Conduct

- The MORL Series strives to provide a fun and family friendly atmosphere for all ages. Please be respectful. The following will not be tolerated:
  - Foul, crude, or profane language.
  - Disrespectful or unsportsman-like conduct.
  - Any other behavior that the MORL Series race director or track owner deems inappropriate.
- Racers <u>must</u> bring a towel or pit mat to protect the tables.
- Racers <u>must</u> pick up their own trash at the end of the day.
- Please keep the restrooms neat and clean. We're not your mother; nobody's getting paid to clean them.
- The sand buckets are for Li-Po battery fires only. They're not to be used for general trash or discarding your safe, used batteries.
- LiPo batteries <u>must</u> be charged in flame retardant charging sacks designed for LiPo batteries.
- The MORL Series is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
- Unless given specific permission by the race director, <u>you must marshal</u> the race immediately following yours

# Super Stock Slash

 Car is based on either the stock Slash SCT or new Modified chassis and suspension, or any combination of either.

• Minimum Ride Height: 13mm

Minimum Weight: N/A

Motor: Traxxas 12T Titan or BL-2

Gearing: Traxxas Slash spur gears only, any pinion

Transmission: 272 or 272r are allowed
Battery Voltage: ROAR Legal 2s - 8.44
Battery Temperature: 90 degrees F

• ESC: Stock or BL-2

 Tires: Non-aggressive SCT on-road rubber tires, no foam tires. (Stock Slash tires are not allowed)

Body: Any full fendered body.

Additional Notes: Shocks can be either Traxxas Ultra shocks or GTR shocks. Shock towers
can be replaced with aftermarket ones for reliability. No additional weight allowed.

## Traxxas Modified (Box Stock)

• Chassis: Stock

Minimum Ride Height: 13mm

Minimum Weight: No additional weight allowed

Motor: StockGearing: Stock

Battery Voltage: ROAR Legal 2s - 8.44
 Battery Temperature: 90 degrees F
 ESC: Stock, battery plug can be changed

• Tires: Stock, sidewalls can be glued - (must be street tread or slick to run at Lower Level)

• Body: Stock - can ONLY trim away material to avoid wheel rub or surface contact.


 Additional Notes: Transmitter and receiver can be changed. Shock oil, limiters and differential oil can be changed. Everything else must remain stock.



#### Rule addendum (10/27/2024)

Parts #4214, #3934, and #2579 can be used to secure the front of the body. A hole for the body post will be drilled at the dimple in front of the body hood (see pic). A hole to secure the post will be drilled just behind the center rib in the front bumper on the flat spot. (See pic) Post will be cut just above 6th hole from bottom of post to leave 6 holes on post. Round edges of cut post. Install screw from bottom of bumper into post. Secure body with pin. This is due to many bodies coming loose during races.





## Vintage Trans Am (VTA)

- Note: The Gravity GRC2025 SCALE SPEC 25.5 (30deg fixed timing) motor is the only legal motor for this class.
- The only deviation from the official rules is that a driver figure is not mandatory.

### **Busch Pancar**

#### Chassis:

- Must run diff-style rear axle.
- Any rear wheel drive pan car chassis. NO SPOOLS
- Spur gear must be on right side.
- No idler gear setups.
- Stock pan car motor mounting only.
- Motors must be mounted to run in counter clockwise rotation....
- (( Left Side Drive pods will be Illegal Starting September 15 2024. ))

#### Tires:

Must use WGT Purple or Blue stripe only. Big carpet events are limited to 3 fronts / 3 rears allowed for racing (marked in tech)(not sets but just 6 tires total for the event) (MORL, Firecracker Classic, etc.).

- John's BSR Tires Purple/ Blue Stripe

- Jaco (white rim w/ purple stripe)

#### **Bodies:**

For all approved bodies:a spoiler with a maximum height of 1.5" from the deck lid used may be (spoiler optional). Wings of any type may not be used. Rear of body left in (cut to rear bumper cut line). 4 1/4" roof height/ 2 1/2" center of front hood height.

Would like bodies to resemble NASCAR-style paint schemes, with door and roof numbers along with grill and headlights. Can be stickers or Painted

Body scraping is not allowed or any other means for the purpose of lightening.

#### Gearing:

Must use 48 pitch 81 tooth spur and 21 to 35pinion.

#### **Electronics:**

No Receiver packs allowed.

MUST USE BRUSHED ESCS ONLY.

#### Motor:

Must use Axial 27 turn brushed motor PN# AXIC24004. Motors cannot be opened from original factory state. You can solder direct. **No fans** allowed on the motor during racing. No 'freezing' motor with the intent of motor to be below ambient temperature at the start of the race. Clip-on heat sinks allowed.

Motors must be mounted to run in counter clockwise direction, and on the right side pod plate.

#### Battery:

- 2 Cell Shorty packs. 5000mah or below.
- Cost MSRP \$59.99 or below

## Weight and Ride Height:

- 36 ounces race ready.
- 4mm ride height.
- Rules may be tweaked and changed as needed.
